

Cardiac CT for Calcium Scoring

What is a Coronary Calcium Scoring Scan?

It is one of the newer more accurate assessment tools to evaluate whether you may be at increased risk for a heart attack or stroke. Using our high-tech Low Dose CT scanner, we can obtain information about the presence, location and extent of calcified plaque in the coronary arteries. A graded score is determined and CAD risk assessed.

Major risk factors for CAD:

- High cholesterol
- Family history of heart attacks
- Diabetes
- High blood pressure
- Cigarette smoking
- Overweight
- Physical inactivity

How Should I prepare?

4 hours prior to the exam:

- NO Caffeine
- NO Smoking
- NO ED medications
- NO Food (but patients are encouraged to drink plenty of water)

The exam takes less than 20 minutes.
